Maths

This half-term will continue to work on multiplication and division. We will be exploring how to multiply a 3-digit number by a l-digit number. We will also begin looking at length, perimeter and area.

English

In English, we will explore a piece of poetry at the beginning of term and will then move onto writing a narrative based on the Romans.

Science

This half-term our topic is magnetic forces. We will investigate friction, the magnetic poles, and which materials are magnetic or

non-magnetic.

PE

PE will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. On Mondays, we will be developing our gymnastics skills, focusing on sequences and controlled movements.

On Wednesdays, we will be swimming. Children will need to come to school in PE kit and bring their swimming bag with them. NOTE: swimming commences 15th January.

RE

In RE, our big question is 'What is it like to follow God?' We will think about the story of Noah and how this links to Christian weddings. We will also explore the meaning of 'people of God'.

History

Our focus this half-term is 'Why were the Romans so powerful?' We will explore when and how Romans invaded Britain, and what was life like in Leintwardine.
