name the continents of the world and find them on a map  
name the world's oceans and find them on a map  
name the major cities of England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland  
find where they live on a map of the UK  
explain why some places in the world are hotter/colder than others.

name and locate further towns and cities in the UK  
understand why Great Britain and the United Kingdom are not the same  
make inferences about weather conditions in other countries of the world
